



TREE PLANTING DESIGN PROPOSAL:
The existing landscape along Karratha Road is relatively barren and devoid of tree or shrub cover to any great extent. While some very good trees can be found in the immediately vicinity of the Visitors Center and in the lower-lying drain, various stages of road works has meant little tree cover remains along the road verge.
The planting proposal for this area would incorporate tree planting from about the 60km sign right down to Dewitt junction with the aim of 'greening' up this important stretch of road into Karratha City.
Native species of trees, planted informally along the road verge will help to create a sense of arrival and also frame and define the entrance to the city. Trees will provide a pleasant year-round feature and help to settle the new construction works into the surrounding hills. Tree planting along the new pedestrian path will provide shade to this exposed area as well as creating a pleasant and interesting backdrop for those using the path.
