## Our survey approach

The Annual Community Survey gathers feedback from the community on how we have performed over the past 12 months and what our priorities should be in the future

- 1608 completed responses, similar to last year's uptake (1562)
- The survey was open for four weeks
- Specific demographics were targeted via promoted Facebook posts, and sponsored Instagram in feed posts.
- 100% of respondents completed the survey online
- Last year we introduced performance and importance rating on a number of **liveability factors** not directly managed by Council. These factors were included in this years survey.








#### Compared to the past 12 months...






#### Services gaps: Overall vs Poor opinion






#### Facilities gaps: Overall vs Poor opinion







































## Liveability gaps: Overall opinion




#### Liveability gaps: Overall vs Poor opinion




#### Liveability gaps: town/suburb breakdown
